The Organizer

What Does It Have To Offer?

- A database for all your pictures
 - Organize photos in systematic way
 - Rates pictures on a 1 to 5 scale
 - Sorts or filters pictures by subject, event, date, any criteria you'd like
 - Simple editing
 - Set up albums and *smart* albums
 - View on the big screen or side by side
 - Sends your pictures to family and friends

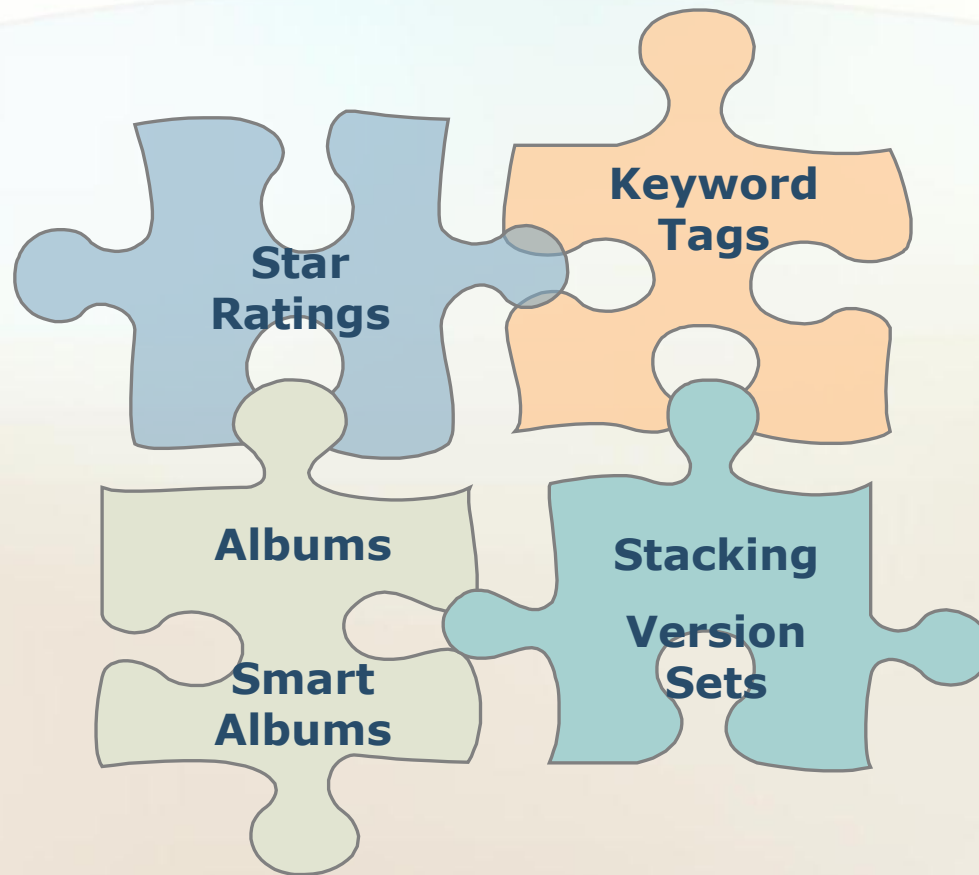
