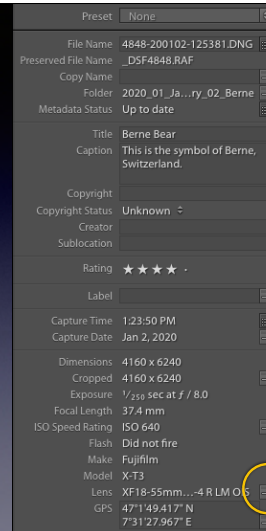
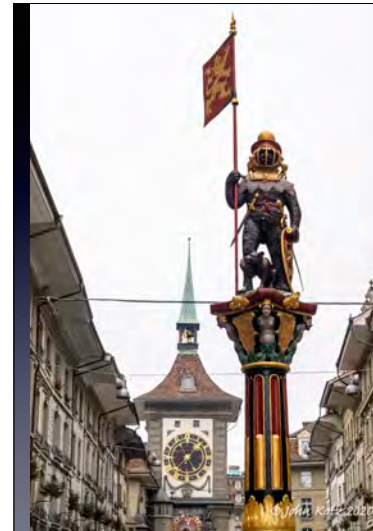


Lightroom Develop Tools

Searchable field

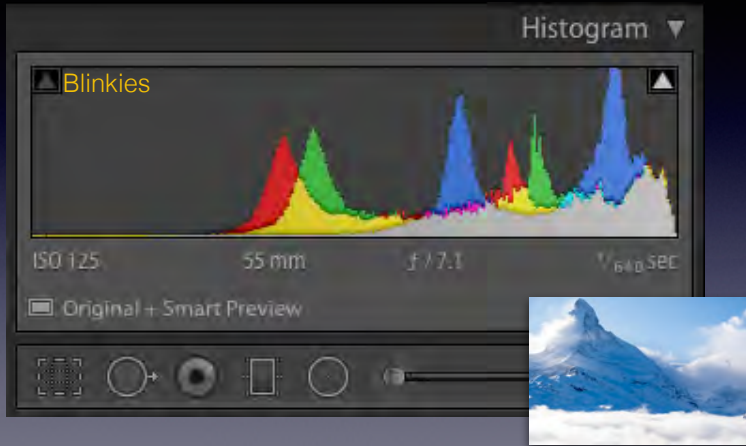
Develop/Editing

- Non-destructive editing!!!!
- Will do about 90% or more of what Photoshop can do.
- Exceptions include exposure blending, focus stacking (but LR can create panoramas and produce HDR images).
- Links to Photoshop, Nik, Topaz, Luminar, and Photomatix software (for sharpening, color adjustment, B & W, and HDR) for more editing.

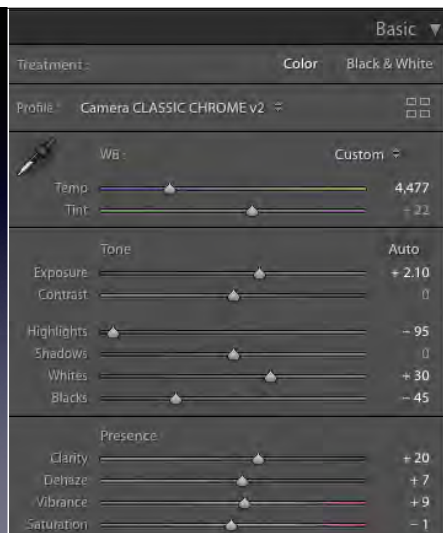

Develop Tools

- The BASIC panel is almost the only editing you need.
- Try AUTO first.
- Tweak others next: Temp, Exposure, Contrast, Whites, Blacks.
- Adding some Clarity and Vibrance is good.
- Adding a bit of Dehaze works well.
- HIGHLIGHTS can deepen skies and enhance clouds.



Profile

PROFILE: standard Adobe profiles listed as well as ones unique to your camera. Can be a good place to begin when editing.

White balance

Tone adjust

CLARITY: boosts apparent contrast in midtones but does not affect overall global contrast. Use negative clarity in B&W and with people.

DEHAZE: especially good for night photos.

Clarity Dehaze Vibrance

VIBRANCE: the less saturated colors get more of a boost than those colors already saturated.
